

## Projects coming to the plant

Water district staff will solicit bids in late summer for construction of a maintenance building, with plans to award the contract in the fall.

Aimed at supporting plant operations, the new facility will warehouse spare parts and provide working space for plant maintenance staff.

The water district has not set an exact timetable for construction of the one-story building, located near the current operations building at the top of the plant.

Construction work, however, will not yield any significant noise or traffic. The water district will notify neighbors before potential impact activities begin.
