Enclosed is the FY 21 Q2 performance report, which, per Board policy, is monitored by reporting on the Board Appointed Officer's (BAO) Ends Policy Outcome Measures. This report is one of the ways that the Santa Clara Valley Water District Board of Directors (the Board) monitors the degree to which the Board policies are being met by the Chief Executive Officer.

This report summarizes the status of 108 Outcome Measures, grouped by each Board Ends Policy Objective. Overall, in Q2, 86% of the Ends Outcome Measures (93 of 108) are on target or were met versus 83% (90 of 108) reported last quarter; 10% have been or will be adjusted (11 of 108) versus 13% (14 of 108) reported last quarter.

Specifically, four percent (4 of 108) are not on target for the reasons below:

OM-2.1.1.e At least 95% of countywide water supply wells meet primary drinking water standards.

Elevated nitrate in South County (primarily domestic wells) resulted in 87% of wells tested meeting primary standards (this increases to 100% if nitrate is not included). Action Plan: Continue to implement the free domestic well testing and nitrate treatment system rebate programs for domestic wells; continue efforts to work with regulatory and land use agencies to address this long-term issue.

There was no change from the previous quarter

OM-2.1.1.g At least 90% of wells in both the shallow and principal aquifer zones have stable or decreasing concentrations of nitrate, chloride, and total dissolved solids.

This measure is not met for chloride, with 82% of wells having water with stable or decreasing concentration trends, but is met for TDS and nitrate. Action Plan: Implement Salt and Nutrient Management Plans to address salt loading, continue collaborating with regulatory and land use agencies.

There was no change from the previous quarter.

OM-3.2.1.a 90% of Water Resource Protection Ordinance violations are resolved.

79 cases were opened 10/1/20 - 12/31/20, 30 (38%) were resolved within the quarter versus 14 cases (19%) in the previous quarter, 49 (62%) remained open at the end of Q2 versus 61 cases (81%) at the end of Q1. The latest numbers seem to indicate that things are starting to improve; staff continue efforts to catch up from delays due to the pandemic; efforts to prioritize our neighborhood encroachments before other violations hinder staff's ability to resolve cases quickly.

OM-4.1.1.k Perform 52 annual clean-ups for the duration of the Safe, Clean Water program to reduce the amount of trash and pollutants entering the streams.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic no encampment sites were cleaned up during FY21 Q2. Local agencies, including Valley Water, have ceased encampment cleanups until further notice is received that it is safe for all involved to proceed.

There was no change from the previous quarter.

These performance areas are monitored quarterly by Watersheds and Water Utility Enterprise and their status is reported to the CEO.

As part of the Board's desire to govern transparently and effectively, the Board's role is to serve as the initiator of policy and delegator of authority to its BAO's.

The organization's performance toward accomplishing the Board's Ends policy goals and objectives is the responsibility of the Board Appointed Officers. Through the BAOs' interpretation of these policies, Outcome Measures are derived and implemented through the budget process and guide development of project and individual staff work plans. These plans specify operational activities to be implemented to achieve the Board's direction for the organization.

The BAOs analyze and monitor organizational performance through operational Quarterly Management Reviews and report results to the Board through Quarterly Performance Reports, as required by Board-BAO Linkage Policy 5.4:

All policies which instruct the BAOs will be monitored at a frequency and by a method chosen by the Board. The Board can monitor any policy at any time by any method, but will ordinarily depend on a routine schedule. Frequency = Quarterly.

The performance of the Outcome Measures are regularly monitored to ensure that they are achieved and meet the Board's expectations and are used to monitor the CEO's performance.

The alignment of the Board policies, BAO Interpretations, and the Budget Process supports a cycle of continual improvement. The outcomes from monitoring either reinforce existing Board policy or facilitate recommended policy changes for Board consideration.

January 2021

In accordance with the Santa Clara Valley Water District Board (Valley Water) Investment policy, staff provides a detailed investment report to the Board of Directors on a quarterly basis. In addition to the quarterly investment report, Government Code section 53607 requires the Treasurer of the local agency who has been delegated with the authority to invest funds to provide a monthly report of the investment transactions to the legislative body. This report is provided to the Board in compliance with Government Code section 53607 and Executive Limitation-4 Financial Management.

Attached is the report of investments for the month of January 2021. All investments were in compliance with the Investment Policy and performed on par with Valley Water's benchmark yield. The attached report includes a summary of the portfolio holdings, details of each security in the portfolio and an investment activity summary with comparisons to the previous 12 months. The following are highlights of the investment activities for the month:

- The book value of Valley Water's portfolio as of January 31, 2021, was \$723.6 million.
- Valley Water's portfolio is invested with a primary goal of safety. To accomplish this goal, we only invest in securities that are permitted by California Government Code and the Board Investment Policy. These securities have high credit ratings and maturities of no more than 5 years. As of January 31, 2021 approximately 63% of the portfolio was held in US Government Treasury/Agency/Municipal Bonds, 35% was held in liquid funds (Local Area Investment Fund, money market mutual fund, and short-term deposits), and 3% in supranational/corporate medium-term notes.
- The portfolio had a yield-to-maturity of 1.172% for the month of January 31, 2021. This is 0.09% above Valley Water's benchmark, the 24-month floating average of the 2-year Treasury note, which was 1.082%. The portfolio yield is expected to continue to decline due to the overall lower interest rate environment.
- Valley Water's portfolio is reviewed every month for compliance with the Investment Policy. All investments were in compliance for the reporting period.
- California Government Code requires that a public entity structure its portfolio so that it, at
 minimum, can meet expenditures for the next six months. The investment portfolio has been
 structured to ensure that sufficient monies will be available to cover anticipated expenditures in
 the coming six months.

The 50th annual Report on Protection and Augmentation of Water Supplies (PAWS), 2021 was filed with the Clerk of the Board on February 26, 2021 as required by the District Act. It contains the recommended groundwater production and other water charges for fiscal year 2021-22. Also posted at the above URL, or linked from that page, are the notices to well owners and surface water users, which describe the rate-setting process, give the rationale for the determination of proposed rates, and provide the dates and times of upcoming public hearings. These notices were mailed to all well owners and surface water users of record on February 26. Note that there are four notices, a groundwater and a surface water notice for North County Modified Zone W-2 and a groundwater and a surface water notice for South County (Zones W-5, W-7 and W-8). A total of 914 North County and 4,338 South County customers receive these notices. The information will also be shared with subscribers to the district's 30,000+ eNewsletter in March.
