Replacement Project (Project No. 10394001)

The Santa Clara Valley Water District (Valley Water) prepared a Final Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the proposed Palo Alto Flood Basin Tide Gate Structure Replacement Project (Project) to fulfill Valley Water's lead agency responsibilities under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Valley Water is responsible for funding the Project, replacing the tide gate structure, and monitoring the improvement work after construction is complete.

The Project is subject to CEQA as the Project requires discretionary approval requiring the exercise of judgement or deliberation by the Valley Water Board of Directors and the activities would be directly undertaken by Valley Water as a public agency, which include public works construction activities, which may cause either a direct physical change in the environment, or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment. The MND is being submitted to the Board for their information prior to the Board meeting scheduled for May 11, 2021.

The Project is located in the City of Palo Alto along the intersection of the San Francisco Bay and the Palo Alto Flood Basin (PAFB). The objective of the Project is to maintain flood protection in the communities surrounding the PAFB and along the US-101 corridor by preventing failure of the existing tide gate structure, upsizing the structure to function with 2 feet of future sea-level rise, and maintaining or improving the current level of flood protection for Matadero, Adobe, and Barron Creeks. The Project would involve construction of a new 132-foot-long tide gate structure slightly inboard (upstream) and southeast of the existing 113-foot-long deteriorating tide gate structure, removal of the existing tide gate structure and levee, and construction of a new levee that ties into the new tide gate structure.

Pursuant to CEQA, Valley Water, as the lead agency for the Project, prepared a Final MND, which is included in this Memo for Board's consideration prior to approving the Project. The Draft MND was circulated for public review from September 14, 2020 to October 15, 2020. Comments on the Draft MND were received from the San Francisco Bay Trail Project, Enid Pearson, Santa Clara County Roads and Airport Department, Santa Clara County Parks and Recreation Department, City of Palo Alto, San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board, and California Department of Fish and Wildlife. The Final MND addresses comments received on the Draft MND. As discussed in the attached Final MND, the Project would result in no or less than significant impacts in all resource areas except biological resources. However, potentially significant impacts on biological resources would be reduced to a less than significant level with implementation of mitigation measures proposed in the Final MND and included in the MMRP (Appendix G of the Final MND).

Prior to approving the Project, CEQA requires the Board to review and consider the information contained in the Final MND. When adopting the Final MND, the Board will also need to adopt the MMRP. Board adoption of the Final MND and MMRP will indicate the Valley Water's formal commitment to implement such measures.
