Valley Water Level of Service:





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


Project Objectives:

- Provide flood protection from the 100-year flood event
- Meet the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) freeboard requirement for flood protection elements
- Improve maintenance access
- Minimize the need for seasonal removal of sediment and vegetation
- Improve biological conditions with mitigation planting
- Improve trail access in the area



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Flood Protection Elements:

- Concrete U-frame between VTA/BART railroad and North Milpitas Boulevard
- Headwalls at bridges
 - Headwalls at North Milpitas Boulevard and Arizona Avenue are separated from the bridge
- 11 Floodwalls from VTA/Bart to upstream of Arizona Avenue
- Install asphalt trail on levee maintenance road along Lower Berryessa Creek




North Milpitas Boulevard to VTA/BART Railroad:

Asphalt Trail along Lower Berryessa Creek






What to Expect During Construction:

- Temporary closure of trail along Lower Berryessa
 Creek
- Weekday work: 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- Hauling trucks will not be allowed before the start of the schedule
- Our contractor is not allowed to park on residential streets
- There will be heavy equipment, dust, vibration and noise
- Noise and traffic control measures are in place to help lessen these impacts
- If weekend work is needed, notification will be
 sent to inform you



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- ▶ Before <u>and</u> after construction
 - ► Homeowner(s) that provided permission to enter (3 owners)
 - ► Valley Water and Contractor's Inspector will take notes, photos and videos of homes and streets/sidewalks.



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Schedule:

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- Award construction contract May 25, 2021
- Notice to Begin Work June 15, 2021
- Pre-construction public meeting June 15, 2021
- Complete civil and landscape construction Dec 2022
- Three Year Planting Establishment and Maintenance Dec 2025



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

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
